**NEW BUSINESS**

Shiva Siddhi, LLC dba Holiday Inn, 3615 Kelly Avenue - Class A Beer/Wine.

Motion made by Fire Chief Kurt Nelson approve the liquor license for Shiva Siddhi, dba Holiday Inn, seconded by Liquor Commission Member Timm Schwartz. On roll call vote present voted Aye. Motion carried.

Discussion: Attorney Sue Bosich had some questions on the application. Agent section needed to be filled out and had Mitesh Patel sign and date application.

Liquor Commission Member Timm Schwartz made a motion to post-pone the liquor license for Flynn Store, Inc. dba Gingoteague indefinitely until all information is needed by Inspections, Police Department and Fire Department. On roll call vote present voted Aye. Motion carried.

**ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

Video Gaming discussion: Liquor Commissioner Rick VonRohr had Washington, Illinois' new Liquor Code regarding Video Gaming. Attorney Sue Bosich will get information from the State of Illinois Liquor

Commission on “stacking” video gaming parlors/café’s. Liquor Commissioner VonRohr will send copies to all Commission members, he gave Rose the printed copy. Commission Members made a recommendation to have Liquor Commissioner John McCabe talk with City Council Members and get direction on the Video Gaming.

Fire Chief Kurt Nelson provided the Commission with a new form for businesses applying for a Liquor License. The goal is to have a “master” copy that stays with the liquor application packet. The person signing off would ensure that these items are covered (they would take a copy with the to ensure everything is covered if need be) or are not applicable. The applicant will have a copy to understand what we will sign off on. In some cases this form may not be all-inclusive. This form will be part of our policy in applying for a liquor license.

Deputy Liquor Commissioner set the next scheduled Liquor Commission Meeting to Thursday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 4:00pm due to the regular scheduled of November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 meeting would fall on Thanksgiving Day.

Fire Chief Kurt Nelson made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Liquor Commission Member Schwartz. Meeting adjourned at 4:35 P.M.
