The reading list is out to the two Sergeants who will be taking the test.

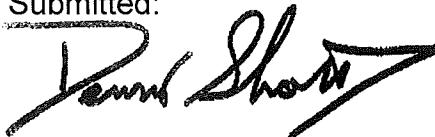

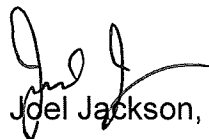
