All Other Business:

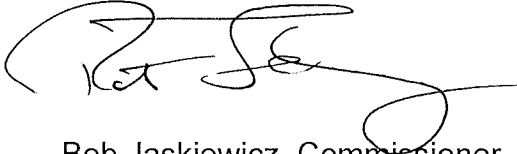
