Assessment Centers. At the next meeting, there will be discussion regarding testing dates and what company to use for Original Appointment Testing and Promotional Assessment Centers.

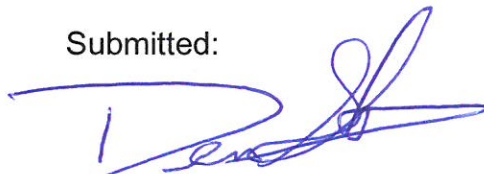

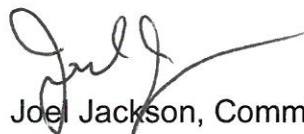
