

CITY OF PEKIN TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m.

Motion by Trent to approve the agenda, seconded by John. All in favor.

Motion by John to approve the June 4, 2021 meeting minutes, seconded by Trent. All in favor.

Old Business:

1. Handicapped Parking Request – 4 N. 19th St.

Josie spoke with Dennis Green, Executive Director Pekin Housing Authority, regarding this request. Units number 4, 6, and 10 are handicapped accessible units. After discussion of this agenda item, Trent made a motion to place handicapped parking signs in front of the three handicapped units. Seconded by John. All in favor. There was a question regarding whether this needs to go before City Council.

New Business:

1. Speed of Traffic on Glendale Ave.

The speed spy monitoring system was placed in this area. The results indicated that the average speed in this location is 28 mph. Crash history was also reviewed. After discussion John made a motion to leave the area as is at this time and Officers will step up enforcement, seconded by Mike. All in favor.

2. Speed of Traffic on Valle Vista Blvd. (where the street ends)

The speed spy monitoring system was placed in this area. The results indicated that the average speed in this location is 14 mph. John made a motion to leave the area as is, seconded by Trent. All in favor.

Around the Table

Trent asked about the signal timing (missing a cycle) at the intersection of Broadway and 14th St. This will be an agenda item for the next meeting.

John reported that the department is working on a grant for a safety message board and another grant for a trailer and outfitting for traffic incidents.

John will put out a request for Officers to spend time in the construction zones as time allows between calls for service.

Josie reported that the intersection of Koch St. and S. 10th St. will be closed for a week for water main work.

Mike reported that the school busses will start running on August 16th.
