New Business:

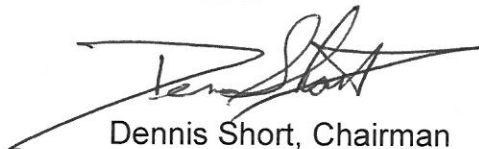
PD – Military Service Credit

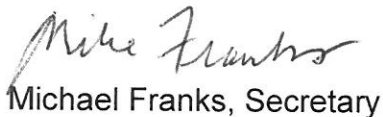
