Notice and proper posting of a special meeting to Receive, File and Award Annual Street Maintenance Bids was received by Council on Monday, May 24, 2004.

As provided by Resolution No. 237, establishing the procedure for appointing a mayor pro tem, Com'r. Maddox was selected by alphabetical rotation to preside at this meeting.

The **Pledge of Allegiance** was led by Mayor Pro Tem Maddox.

Roll was called and all commissioners were present except Com'r. Jones. Mayor Howard was absent. A quorum was present.

Agenda

Motion by Com'r. Richmond, seconded by Com'r. Massaglia, that the **agenda be approved as presented**. On roll call vote, all present voted Aye.

New Business

Motion by Com'r. Massaglia, seconded by Com'r. Richmond, that the **ANNUAL STREET MAINTENANCE BIDS BE RECEIVED AND FILED AND THE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,058,892.90 BE APPROVED AND THE CONTRACT BE AWARDED TO R.A. CULLINAN & SON**. City Manager Dennis Kief informed Council that inasmuch as the low bid received was under 6.38% of his estimate, he recommended that the only bid received be accepted and the contract awarded to R.A Cullinan & Son, Inc. He reported that 100% of the base repair would be completed in advance by the Street Department. Com'r. Massaglia questioned how much the City was saving by completing base repair in-house. Mr. Kief reported the work was cost effective and estimated a savings of between \$50,000-\$100,000. The amount would be confirmed with comparison figures in the public works department. Mr. Kief also confirmed that he had made a commitment for brick street work for the summer crew but they would alternate depending on job load for base repairs. On roll call vote, all present voted Aye.

No further business to come before the Council, a motion was made by Com'r. Massaglia, seconded by Com'r. Richmond that Council adjourn. On roll call vote, all present voted Aye.
