Valeria Breier was presented **CERTIFICATE OF HONORARY CITIZENSHIP** and given several City of Pekin logo items by Mayor Tebben. Bob and Michelle Small were recognized for their hospitality in hosting the German student in their home.

Appreciation was extended by Chief Tim Gillespie to **GREG SCHAEFER** for his voluntary service on the Fire and Police Commission from September 1992-March 2000.

The City Manager Dick Hierstein introduced Larry Gleason from Cost, Planning & Management, International, Inc. CPMI. The company worked with the administration and staff to study **FACILITY PLANNING** options for City Hall offices. Mr. Gleason reviewed the examination, which covered existing facilities, previous planning efforts and record documents. The Company evaluated the condition and capacity of mechanical and electrical systems. A two Volume Report was given to Council. No action was taken on the options presented.

Motion by Com'r. Barra, seconded by Com'r. Orrick, that Ordinance No. 1462-A175 be adopted. Public Works Director Dennis Kief explained that the two previous ordinances were matters of house keeping for the newly completed intersection. Striping would be completed on Wednesday. On roll call vote, all present voted Aye.

Council agreed to set the date for the **BUS TOUR OF CITY PROJECTS** for Monday, May 15, 200 @ 3:30 p.m.

Other Business

A written request from Illinois American Water Company to address Council for just a few minutes at the next meeting was received. The Mayor felt he did not want to limit the company representative's time and asked if Council was willing to call a special meeting with one agenda item of business. The Clerk was directed to post May 3, 2000 at 3:30 p.m. as the selected date if IAWC confirmed their attendance.

Council extended appreciation to City employees for their joint efforts in cleaning up after the windstorm of last week.

Public Properties Director Greg Ranney announced that the Pekin Bus transportation service had been extended to stops at Pekin Estates.

Mayor Tabbed reported that Illinois House of Representative Keith Summer informed him that SB1453

that would allow quarterly reporting of sales tax was gutted in the House and Senate. The Department of Revenue was directed to study the issue.

Reporters from the Peoria Journal Star, the Pekin Daily Times and news media stations were given the opportunity to ask questions.

Motion by Com'r. Barra, seconded by Com'r. Orrick, that Council move to **Executive Session** at 6:50 P.M. to discuss Personnel and Litigation. On roll call vote, all present voted Aye.

No further business to come before the Council, a motion was made by Com'r. Barra, seconded by Com'r. Orrick that Council adjourn. Motion carried by voice vote.
