Communications, Petitions, Reports

A public hearing was opened at 5:30 p.m. for the purpose of contemplating the adoption of an ordinance authorizing the annexation to the City of Pekin a tract of property legally described as Lot 6 in Block 1 in Sunnyside Addition PIN # 10-10-09-400-011 and commonly known as 2009 S. 2nd Street. Richard and Jolene Taylor requested the City for annexation as a means for fire protection. That petition was received and filed by Council on February 10, 2003. It was confirmed the tract in Normandale was contiguous with the boundary of the City. Notice of Public Hearing was properly published in the Pekin Daily Times on March 27, 2003 as confirmed by Clerk Sue McMillan. Affidavit of Mailing was served to the appropriate Township, Park District and Fire Protection district trustees. The public was given the opportunity to be heard. No comments or additional information was provided. The Chair closed the Public Hearing at 5:32 p.m.
