6.1. Deaf Child Sign Request, Coolidge St.

The committee discussed the request to move a deaf child sign to 1102 Coolidge. The family had previous lived at another address and requested the sign be moved to their new address. A motion was made by Seth to move the deaf child sign to Coolidge St. The motion was seconded by Trent, all approved.

6.2. Speeding Concerns, Amanda and N. 10th St.

The committee discussed this intersection and the possible hazards that incur with having only yield signs. A resident of the street gave testimony to the numerous crashes and close calls they have seen in the last few years. Some of these concerns included increased speeding, cars not adhering to yield signs, children in front yards, and a jog in the intersection itself. The committee decided it would be the best and safest choice to change the yield

signs to stop signs. A motion was made by Seth to change the two yield signs on N. 10th St. at Amanda Street to stop signs. Trent seconded the motion, all approved. The Police department will also add speed spy and continue enforcement in the area.

Any Other Business to Come Before the Committee

Trent advised the tree in the right of way in the area of N. 10th St. and Amanda St. should be looked at for possible sight line obstruction. Jaimie also noted that she was approached by Councilperson Abel about citizens who've asked about adding speed bumps to residential streets. Seth said he would reach out to Abel for more information and locations.
