PRESENT: MAYOR MACKAMAN, COUNCIL MEMBERS DAGIT, AND BLANCHARD

ABSENT: COUNCIL MEMBER MADDOX AND JONES

Council received proper notice of a meeting because more than one member of the City Council had indicated an interest in attending the Public Input Meeting for Staff to receive comments on a draft ordinance requiring landlord registration on January 31, 2007. The City was required to post the meeting, in addition, as a Special Council meeting under the provisions of the Open Meetings Act.

Mayor Mackaman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll was called. Council Members, Blanchard, and Dagit and Mayor Mackaman were present for Roll Call.

Members of the City Council observed the proceedings of a staff meeting intended to receive public input on proposals to add registration of rental houses and lots as a requirement in the Code. Public Works Director Joe Wuellner and Code Enforcement Officer Ron Sieh advised those in attendance that the staff would accept recommendations for registering property owners but the speakers would be limited to 5 minute comments. After listening to comments directed to a drafted ordinance containing fee schedules, that had been removed from the table, Council Members asked if the landlords represented had a consensus of support for just registration. Comments followed.

The Council took no action.
