6.1. FD - Rules and Regulations Update

The Commission received a brief update on the rules and regulations. This was briefly talked about at the last Commission meeting. The rules and regulations now show that probationary time for the Fire Department was updated to reflect the same standard as the Police Department. The rules and

regulations now reflect that probationary time for Firefighters will start after their training at the Fire Academy has ended. The Commission will be reviewing the rules and regulations in its entirety before sending it to City Council for approval.

Two Firefighters graduated from the Fire Academy last week. They are already paramedics and will be beginning shift work. There is one other Firefighter who is on probation and currently doing administration work. They are expected to move to shift work on Sunday. There are four currently in their paramedic class and doing their internships. They are expected to take their final paramedic test in February.

7.2. PD Departmental Reports

The department has one officer coming off probation and the other three still on probation are on the solo patrol phase. One officer left for a job in another state. The department has one name left on the current list and two on the second list. They anticipate another round of testing sometime this summer.
